Support for Returnees / Children from Overseas Project

At the Sendai City Board of Education, we dispatch volunteers to schools to assist elementary and junior high school students who require help with Japanese. Volunteers support the students by providing Japanese assistance and helping to explain lessons conducted in Japanese until the students get used to their school. Each support session lasts two hours, with sessions available up to 40 times. If you would like to use this service, please first discuss with school teachers.

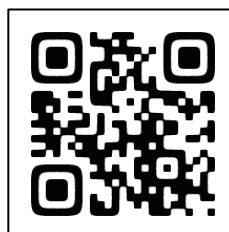


OASIS (Open Assist & Support in Sendai)

Support Group for Children of Foreign Residents

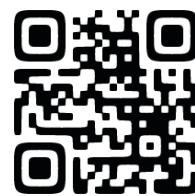
This is a citizens' group that supports children of foreign residents in their efforts to study Japanese and other academic subjects.
